

As you get to know God more, you find that you want to talk about Him more. And when you talk about Him and listen to others talk about Him, it will help you see God in new ways.




### HONOR GOD WITH YOUR LIFE

## PRAYER Dialogue with God

In gK! we use the "Prayer Hand" as a helpful approach for teaching kids to pray. It's a format that allows children to recall and pray in their own words the five distinctive elements of prayer.





#### **READ 1 CORINTHIANS 1:25**

Do what you need to do, then watch what God can do. Sometimes we think God needs us to do our part before He can do HIS part. Shocking as it may be, though, God doesn't need us at all. God can do it ALL by Himself.

Instead, God gives us opportunities to participate in His work for OUR benefit and for HIS glory. When we choose to work with Him, our faith in Him increases, we get to have a part in His perfect plan, and we realize just how much He loves us.

DRAW A PICTURE OF SUNDAY'S BIBLE STORY AND MAKE SURE TO DRAW THE BOY WHO SHARED HIS LUNCH.

THINK ABOUT THIS: DID GOD NEED THE LUNCH TO FEED THE CROWD?

THANK GOD FOR ALLOWING YOU TO BE HIS TEAMMATE AND CO-WORKER. ASK GOD HOW HE WANTS TO USE YOU THIS WEEK.



### **READ JOHN 6: 9-10; JUDGES 7:2-3, 7**

Here's the world's easiest Math problem:

If you have a box of cookies and you share them with others, do you now have MORE or LESS cookies? Now think about the boy who shared his lunch. At the end of the story did he have MORE or LESS lunch? WHAT?! How'd that happen? Easy – God Math!

Do you know God Math? It's nothing like ours! For instance, according to God Math:

5 loaves + 2 fish = enough food to feed 5,000 (plus leftovers) 1 lost sheep = as valuable as 99

Gideon was a leader of God's army. But God told him. 'Your army of 32,000 is way too large to defeat the Midianites.' Too large? Wait. What?

Twice, God had Gideon actually reduce his army – until it was small enough to win the battle. Small enough?

God would give Gideon's army the victory, but he wanted them to rely on him and not their own strength.

Gideon's army of 300 was outnumbered - 450 to one! But remember God Math?

God + nothing = everything Everything - God = nothing

"It is not by force nor by strength, but by my spirit," says the Lord.

Zechariah 4:6 (NLT)

God gives us more than we can imagine! And most of the time is doesn't make any sense to us! That's why we have to depend on Him!

### **READ PSALM 37:25**

We can trust God to meet our needs, and sometimes God even uses us to meet the needs of others! But think about this: maybe God gave you extra of something—more than you need—so you can share with others. And since you can trust God to meet your needs, you can feel free to share what you have, knowing that God will keep on meeting your needs.

Think of someone who has a need that you can meet because God has provided for you.

## DAY 4

### **READ JOHN 6:11**

Pretty simple verse today huh? When Jesus was in the middle of a huge hungry crowd with a little lifeless lunch, what'd He do? He stopped and prayed. He didn't panic, make excuses, or catch a bus out of town. He simply prayed. Because He knew God was a Provider, he knew the story was going to end well.
