Parents: Tell your child about a time that someone helped you. Kids: Share a time that someone showed you God's love.

Read the story of the Triumphal Entry in Matthew 21:1-11. Re-enact the story or make up a mad-lib, inserting the wrong nouns/adjectives from the story and see if your child will correct you.

As you drive around town talk to your child about what communion is. Have they ever seen communion? Explain how we take communion, dipping the wafer in the grape juice and eating it. Explain how the wafer represents the body of Christ that was sacrificed on the cross for our sins. Explain that the juice represents the blood of Christ that washes away our sins. We take communion every Sunday at church to stop and remember that Jesus died for us. As a matter of fact, Jesus told them to take communion "in remembrance of me."

Take a most and remember that Jesus died for you! Every time you stop at a stop sign or red light, say "Jesus died for you!"
