### **About Oviedo.**

Oviedo is a suburb of Orlando located in eastern Seminole County. The population is around 37,000 people, giving it both a small-town feel and all the benefits of a world-class city nearby. Oviedo is convenient to The University of Central Florida and the Central Florida Research Park, which makes it a prime location for development and family living. In fact, Oviedo was named on Bloomberg's "Best Places to Raise Kids" in 2018 and *Money Magazine's* "Best Places to Live" in 2008. Ten elementary schools, six middle schools, and four high schools serve the Oviedo/Winter Springs area.

### **About Grace Oviedo's Family Ministry (Birth-12th grade).**

Currently, the Family Ministry at Grace Oviedo averages 160+ kids and students each week, from birth through 12th grade. Our graceKIDS! ministry especially has grown tremendously over the past few years, and we are seeking to develop our Grace Students ministry at this campus, too, as it continues to grow. A team of 90+ volunteers serves on our Family Ministry team

### **About the Family Director position.**

We are looking for a person qualified in experience, heart, and vision to oversee our graceKIDS! and Grace Students ministries. This Family Director position will be a vital part of a Family Ministry team that works to provide a comprehensive, effective discipleship plan for the next generation, from birth through high school.

We believe that it is both our responsibility and privilege to creatively engage the next generation with a gospel-centered ministry. We believe in the value and importance of partnering with parents in their spiritual growth and development. It's our desire to see our kids, infants through students, equipped with the gospel, trained in the Word, and given the skills to go and make disciples of all nations — while having a whole lot of fun along the way.

### **Requirements and Qualifications.**

## **Primary Job Duties.**

- Implement the mission of graceKIDS! and Grace Students at the Oviedo campus: partnering with parents to help kids and students take their next steps toward Christ.
- Lead and communicate the vision and philosophy of Family Ministry that builds from birth through high school — partnering with parents, creating small groups and leaders, discipleship, spiritual growth, and living on mission.
- Collaborate with the network leads of GraceKIDS! and Grace Students at the Orlando campus
- Adopt a “training leaders” mindset, providing support in the development (recruiting, training, supervising) and nurturing of Family Ministry leadership and volunteer leaders.
- Recruit, develop and train lay leaders to help implement and run our ministries; supervise ministry leaders in the selection and training of lay leaders and volunteers.
- Oversee Family Ministry leaders in process/program development and educational materials (provided by the network) for all programs and activities.
- Establish annual goals with Family Ministry leaders that are consistent with our vision and values.
- Provide administrative leadership for long-range planning, budgeting, and calendar coordination.
- Lead each ministry through an annual evaluation process to ensure fulfillment of goals.
- Partner with parents to lead their kids & students to become growing disciples.
- Increase the visibility of Family Ministry to the entire congregation and to the surrounding community.
- Provide direction for and coordination of Family Ministry during regular meetings.
- This position will report to the Oviedo Campus Pastor.
