- Adopt a "training leaders" mindset, providing support in the development (recruiting, training, supervising) and nurturing of Family ministry leadership and volunteer leaders.
- Recruit, develop and train lay leaders to help implement and run the Grace Student ministry; supervise ministry leaders in the selection and training of lay leaders and volunteers
- Establish annual goals with Family ministry leaders that are consistent with our vision and values.
- Provide administrative leadership for long-range planning, budgeting, and calendar coordination.
- Partner with parents to lead their students to become growing disciples.
- Increase the visibility of Grace Student ministry to the entire congregation and to the surrounding community.
